1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 MEIL ANPARA ENERGY LIMITED (hereinafter referred to as '**MAEL**') a company incorporated under the Companies Act, 1956, having its registered office at H. No. C/02/177, Sector C Pocket 2 Sushant Golf City, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh, India, 226030. MAEL is operating 2 x 600 MW Anpara 'C' coal based Thermal Power Station at P.O-Anpara, District Sonbhadra, (National Highway-39) Uttar Pradesh-231225.

Ash is generated as a by-product in the process of generation of electricity at the Thermal Power Station. MAEL intends to promote utilization of fly ash/ pond ash as resource material for filling in low lying areas, abandoned mines as per the provisions of MoEF&CC notification dated 31st December 2021. In order to facilitate this, MAEL wishes to allow off take of pond ash for filling in low lying areas and abandoned mines. Ash to be issued "free of cost" and on "as is where is" basis from the ash pond and fly ash silo of 2x600 MW Anpara "C" TPS. Ash pond is situated at village Belwadah which is around 14 KM from Power Station.

1.2 Basic information:

- 1.2.1 Plant capacity :2x600 MW (Unit 1&2).
- 1.2.2 Target Quantity (TQ): Proposed Quantity of Ash – 25,00,000 MT
- 1.2.3 Target time Period: **August 2026 to March 2027**
- 1.2.4 The plant is situated at a distance of about 190 Kms from Varanasi Location: Anpara "C" Thermal Power Station Anpara, Sonbhadra, Uttar Pradesh.
- 1.2.5 Latitude – 24.2052° North Longitude -82.7965° East
- 1.2.6 Nearest Railway Station: Krishna Shila (KRSL); 10Km from Generating Station

2. PROPOSAL:

MAEL invites proposals from interested landowners/mine owners/ representatives for the utilization of ash in low-lying areas and abandoned mines.

The brief scope of work includes excavation of ash from the ash pond and transportation of the ash in covered trucks from the ash pond for disposal and filling in UPPCB-approved low-lying areas and mines in accordance with the applicable CPCB guidelines.

The low-lying area and abandoned mines shall be identified and selected by the landowners/ mine owner/ representatives within distance of 300 km from the ash pond. The landowners/ mine owner/representatives shall also be responsible for obtaining all necessary No Objection Certificates (NOCs) from the landowners, securing the required statutory approvals from the UPPCB for filling the low-lying area and abandoned mines with ash, and coordinating with the local authorities for all related permissions and clearances.

MAEL shall provide ash free of cost on an "as is, where is" basis.

Interested landowners/representatives are requested to submit their proposals in the enclosed format.

3. PRE-BID MEETING AND MANDATORY SITE VISIT

Eligible and interested bidders are required to attend a pre-bid meeting with the MAEL Site Team prior to submitting their bids. The purpose of the meeting is to familiarize bidders with the scope of work, site conditions, ash loading and transportation procedures, safety requirements and other applicable statutory and contractual obligations.

A site visit is **mandatory** for all participating bidders. Upon completion of the site visit, the MAEL Site Team will issue a **Site Visit Clearance Certificate**. Bidders must attach this certificate with their bid documents. **Bids submitted without the Site Visit Clearance Certificate shall be treated as non-responsive and are liable to be rejected.**

4. BID SECURITY

The bidders are required to deposit Earnest Money (EMD) INR 5,00,000 (Rs. Five Lakhs only) for every 1,00,000 MT quoted by the representatives of landowners through DD only to be issued in favor of “MEIL Anpara Energy Limited”, payable at Chennai.

BIDS SUBMITTED WITHOUT THE DEMAND DRAFT FOR THE EARNEST MONEY SECURITY DEPOSIT (EMSD) SHALL BE REJECTED BY MAEL AS NON-RESPONSIVE AND SHALL NOT BE OPENED

5. PERFORMANCE SECURITY

The EMD of the successful bidder shall be converted to Performance Security and shall keep the Performance Security valid till the completion period of work order. EMD of unsuccessful bidder shall be returned within 30 days.

6. NOTES FOR SUBMISSION OF PROPOSAL

- 6.1 Interested Landowners/mine owner /representatives shall be responsible for identifying and selecting the low-lying areas and abandoned mines within distance up to 300 KM.
- 6.2 Interested Landowners/mine owner/ representatives shall be responsible for getting all clearances from appropriate authorities including Pollution Control Board for filling up pond ash in the selected low-lying areas and mines.
- 6.3 Shortlisted landowners/mine owner/ representatives shall be issued a work order specifying the quantity of ash to be lifted from auxiliary pond & ash pond within a stipulated period and the applicable rate (Rs. /MT) towards excavation, loading, transportation and unloading of ash. **The scope of work includes construction of approach road inside the auxiliary pond and ash pond for excavation and loading of ash, transportation of ash in covered trucks and its disposal and filling in UPPCB-approved low-lying areas and mines in accordance with the applicable CPCB guidelines.**
- 6.4 Shortlisting and selection of Landowners/mine owners/ representatives shall be done based on criteria given below: -
Landowners/mine owners/ representatives who have requested Nil or the least financial support from MAEL shall be given priority and quantity committed by the party in its Proposal shall be given first preference for allotment. However, this shall be subject to the satisfaction of MAEL of credentials submitted by Landowners/representatives along with Proposal with regards to availability, readiness and statutory clearances for low lying area and mines together with proof of daily transportation capability. Landowners/mine owner/representatives to note that the primary objective of MAEL for inviting Proposal for utilization of ash in low lying area and abandoned mines is to meet its Environmental obligations and to that end MAEL is at liberty to distribute the TQ mentioned at 1.2.2 to multiple Landowners/mine owners/ representatives and the decision of MAEL in this regard shall be final and binding on all Landowners /representatives.

- 6.5 Prospective Landowners/ mine owners/ representatives shall submit their Proposal for lifting of ash from the ash pond. The Proposal should include the particulars of Landowners/ mine owners/Representatives with the background of operation, business, tentative plan, proposed quantity of ash to be utilized etc. (Annexure-2)
- 6.6 Interested Landowners/ mine owners /representatives will transport the pond ash in an environmentally friendly manner for utilization / consumption as per their requirement at their risk (undertaking as per Annexure-3).
- 6.7 Landowners/ mine owners /representatives may note that transportation of ash shall be subject to provisions of Section (C)(4) of the MoEF& CC notification dated 31st December 2021.
- 6.8 Ash shall be transported only through covered trucks or dumpers.
- 6.9 MAEL shall provide pond ash free of cost and on as is and where is basis; from the ash pond, till the available offered quantity is exhausted.
- 6.10 Mode of packing, loading, transportation and utilization must be clearly mentioned by the interested Landowners/mine owner/ representatives.
- 6.11 Interested Landowners/mine owner/ representatives may clearly indicate the support required from MAEL in Annexure-1.
- 6.12 All the works of ash excavation & loading, transportation and unloading must be executed confirming the EHS rules and regulations of State Pollution Control Board UPPCB.
- 6.13 The Landowners/mine owner/ representatives submitting the proposal shall be bearing all costs associated with the preparation and submission of the proposal and MAEL will, in no case be responsible or liable for these costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the assessment/evaluation process.
- 6.14 In case of non-mobilization / inadequate mobilization, MAEL may, at its discretion, terminate the order and allocate such quantity to alternate Landowners/representatives/ end use avenue(s). Decision of MAEL shall be final and binding in this regard.
- 6.15 In case of any liability on MAEL, in any manner that arises due to non-compliance of any Environmental and Transportation Norms, Rules, Guidelines and Statutory provisions by the successful Landowners/representatives or its agent, during execution and for future obligations (if any) by way of omission or commission, the Successful Landowners/representatives shall keep MAEL effectively indemnified of any such liability. An indemnity bond shall be submitted before start of lifting of Ash.
- 6.16 **MAEL reserves its right to take appropriate action as deemed fit, in case information/ details provided are found false even later.**
- 6.17 MAEL shall issue the Work Order to the selected landowners/mine owners/their authorized representatives for the excavation, loading and transportation of ash from the Auxiliary Ash Pond and the Main Ash Pond. The successful vendor shall first lift ash from the Auxiliary Ash Pond. After the quantity available in the Auxiliary Ash Pond is exhausted, the vendor shall lift ash from the Main Ash Pond, as specified in the Work Order or as directed by the Engineer-in-Charge (EIC) of MAEL.
- 6.18 In the event that Work Orders are issued to multiple landowners/mine owners/their authorized representatives, the quantity of ash available in the Auxiliary Ash Pond shall be distributed equally among the selected proponents, unless otherwise decided by MAEL. Each selected proponent shall mandatorily lift ash from the Auxiliary Ash Pond, subject to the availability of ash.

7. QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENT:

There shall be no Technical and or Financial Criteria for Landowners and mine owners.

However, representatives of Landowners and mine owners shall have following technical & Financial Qualification requirements as given in following sections. Representatives of Landowners and mine owners who do not satisfy the Technical Criteria and Financial Criteria shall be disqualified and their Proposal shall be rejected. Representatives of Landowners and mine owners are also required to submit all relevant forms specified in Technical Criteria and Financial Criteria along with their Proposal failing which the Transporter shall be disqualified, and the Proposal shall be rejected.

Landowner / mine owners/ Representative submitting incomplete or unsigned forms shall also be disqualified and their Proposal shall stand rejected.

8. TECHNICAL CRITERIA

The representatives of Landowners and mine owners should meet the following technical requirements

9. FINANCIAL CRITERIA

Financial Criteria of representatives of Landowners and mine owners: -

The annual turnover of the representatives of Landowners along with its subsidiaries and affiliates in preceding 3 Financial Years shall be Rs. 6 Crores.	Turnover duly certified by Chartered Accountant.

11. PRICE & BID EVALUATION METHODOLOGY:

The bids shall be evaluated based on the following parameters:

1. Quoted Rate (Rs/MT): Lower quoted rate shall be given preference.
2. Distance from Ash Pond to Avenue: Shorter lead distance shall be given preference.
3. Daily Lifting Capacity: Higher committed quantity for daily lifting shall be given preference.

Selection of L1 Bidder:

The L1 bidder shall be determined based on the overall techno-commercial evaluation of the above three parameters. MAEL reserves the right to select the bidder offering the most advantageous combination of quoted rate, lead distance, and daily lifting capacity.
